



DARA 1st Annual Student & Teachers Show

2024 Prospectus

All exhibiting artists agree to DARA's Terms & Conditions described below in order to participate in the show.

CATEGORIES

You are permitted to submit up to 5 works in each category.

- **Category 1:** DARA Student Work
- **Category 2:** DARA Extracurricular Studies / Sketches
- **Category 3:** Personal Work

At least 1 work must be entered into Category 1 OR 2 in order to participate in the show.

ARTWORK

- Accepted artwork includes representational drawings or paintings made with traditional media.
- All artwork entered must have been made by you.
- You may not enter any work that was made in a school or course outside of DARA.
- Any works listed for sale must be given a realistic sales price.
- Works selected for exhibit are chosen by DARA's core instructors.

DEADLINES

Application Deadline: The final day to submit an entry into the show is 26 April.

Notice of Acceptance: All artists will be notified of which works are accepted into the show on 29 April.

Exhibition Dates:

- Friday 24 May: 17:00 - 22:00
- Saturday 25 May: 10:00 - 17:00
- Sunday 26 May: 10:00 - 15:00

Receiving Days: All artwork accepted into the show must be dropped off at the DARA Studio during these hours:

- Saturday 18 May: 10:00 to 15:00
- Sunday 19 May: 10:00 to 15:00
- Monday 20 May: 10:00 to 15:00

Collection of Unsold Work: All unsold work must be picked up from the DARA Studio during the following times:

- Sunday 26 May: 15:00 - 18:00
- Monday 27 May: 9:30 - 16:30
- Tuesday 28 May: 9:30 - 16:30
- Wednesday 29 May: 9:30 - 16:30

A €20 per day late fee is charged for work that is not collected on time.

UPLOADING IMAGES

Images that do not meet these guidelines are automatically disqualified.

- Image files may not exceed 8MB.
- Do not submit low resolution or blurry photos. Images must be minimum 2000px on the smallest side.
- Do not submit screenshots.
- Crop the image to remove any empty space around the margins.
- Lightly editing your photos is acceptable to remove a glare, straighten the image, correct lens distortion, or to crop the edges. Any digital editing that alters the actual appearance of the work is not allowed.
- For each submission, the following information must be indicated: the title of the work, the correct dimensions, the media with which the work was made, and the price (if for sale.)

EXHIBITION RULES

- All accepted work must be dropped off in person at the DARA studio during Receiving Days (see 'Deadlines'.) We are not able to receive shipped artwork.
- Artwork must remain at DARA for the duration of the exhibition.
- Your art must be clearly labeled with your name.
- **Drawings / Works on Paper:** Must be presented in a frame OR with matting, and must be delivered ready to hang.
- **Paintings:** Paintings should be varnished. Must be presented in a frame OR with the edges of the canvas or panel painted. NO loose canvas taped to board. Must be delivered ready to hang.

Work that is not delivered ready to exhibit according to these guidelines will not be shown.

- Unsold work must be collected from the DARA studio on Collection Days [see 'Deadlines'.] A storage fee of €20 per day is charged for any work not collected on time.

SALE OF WORK

- Work listed for sale should be set at a realistic price.
- The sales price includes the frame and/or mat in which the work is exhibited.
- All sales prices are final and may not be changed after your work has been accepted into the show.
- DARA retains a 35% commission of any work sold during the exhibition. The artist's 65% of the sales price is paid on or before 31 May 2024.
- In the event that the artwork must be shipped to the buyer, DARA will arrange for the shipping and handling of the work. The buyer will be responsible for shipping and handling fees.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

By submitting work, you understand and agree that the DARA studio and its staff are not liable for loss or any damage to artwork. All art will be handled with the utmost care and professionalism during the exhibition.

PUBLICITY

By submitting your art into the show, you agree to give DARA permission to use images of your work for advertising or publicity purposes, including publication on our website, social media, newsletter, or printed marketing materials.
